Dear Students and Parents/Guardians:

Schedules, advisory, and locker information have been posted to the parent portal, and you will be receiving a postcard from your new team of teachers welcoming you back to school. All teams will be identified by a type of eagle to celebrate our “Eagle Pride” at the Rocky Point Middle School. On the first day of school, Wednesday, September 5th, all students will report to their advisory class (12-13 students per advisory); **not** their first period class. The advisory classroom location appears in the “Homeroom” section of each student’s schedule. On Thursday, September 6th, students will report to their first period classes.

Students will be participating in an advisory and team experience on the first day of school, Wednesday, September 5th. Students will ensure their lockers are prepared for the following day of classes, prepare their agenda books for the year and become better acquainted with their advisor and students in their advisory team and grade level. After participating in advisory activities that morning, students will move through an abbreviated version of their eight period schedule. Following the morning advisory and modified bell schedule, students will rotate with their grade level between a Code of Conduct Assembly period to review academic and behavior expectations with administration, eat lunch with their grade level for one period, and finally, participate in outdoor activities planned by our PE department for one period. Students will then transition back to their teams for team building competitions and finally back to their advisory to conclude the day. Lastly, students will leave with their “B” day schedule to utilize the following day, Thursday, September 6th. Due to the planned outdoor activities on Wednesday, we strongly suggest students dress appropriately for the warmer weather, wear sneakers, apply sunblock and bring a water bottle.

We are very excited about our advisory and team events that have been planned and look forward to seeing you on the first day of school, Wednesday, September 5th.
