EXECUTIVE SESSION

At 5:01 pm, a motion was made by Sean Callahan and seconded by Edward Casswell to go into Executive Session in order to discuss confidential personnel matters pertaining to select employees and ongoing confidential legal matters.

The Board returned to Open Session at 7:01 pm.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mrs. Sullivan announced that the Board was returning from Executive Session and invited Dr. Ring to begin with the Superintendent's Report.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Dr. Ring welcomed the meeting attendees and wished everyone a Happy Thanksgiving. He reflected on how the school year has progressed so quickly and that the Holidays are upon us, once again. He extended his gratitude to the students and staff for all of their hard work. He also thanked the attendees for coming out just before Thanksgiving to share in this night of special recognitions for many of our talented students and staff. Dr. Ring invited Mr. Delargy up to the podium to begin with the Athletic Department recognitions.

#### MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

#### And the

#### ROCKY POINT SCHOOL-RELATED PROFESSIONALS' ASSOCIATION

THIS MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT is entered into by the Board of Education of the Rocky Point Union Free School District (the "District") and the Rocky Point School-Related Professionals' Association (the "Association"), collectively referred to as the "Parties."

This Agreement is for the purpose of permitting a transfer of up to a total of twenty (20) compensated absence days between specific Association members and, Carolyn Doyle, an individual member of the Association on or before January 3, 2017. Donations of days from less than full-time Association members will be recorded as half days. Said days shall be deemed to be sick days for the purpose of utilization by the aforementioned receiving member of the Association. Furthermore, individual members of the Association may not contribute more than a 20 percent of their presently available sick and/or vacation days to this bank.

This Agreement will automatically "sunset" effective January 3, 2017 and has no validity with respect to §209-a.1(e) of the Public Employees Fair Employment Act, unless extended in writing by the parties. To the extent any transferred days remain unutilized by the receiving member of the Association upon the "sunset" of this Agreement or the separation of employment of the receiving member of the Association, whichever comes first, the balance of the remaining unutilized days shall be returned to the Association members having donated said days on a pro-rata basis, in accordance with the number of days transferred by each member, provided that days shall be returned in increments of 0.5 days and greater only.

The Parties further agree that this Agreement shall not be precedent-setting nor binding upon the Parties in the future. Moreover, the Parties agree that this Memorandum of Agreement shall not be used and/or admitted into evidence in connection with any subsequent claim, litigation, arbitration, cause of action or proceeding of any kind and nature in any jurisdiction or forum.
