 will be certified and recertified, as necessary, in accordance with §30-3.10 of the Rules of the Board of
 Regents for the 2017-18 school year:
- Assure that all data will be submitted to the Commissioner by August 25, 2017, to the extent practicable, and no later than October 27, 2017;
- Assure that the Statement of Confirmation of 2016-17 Staff Evaluation Rating Verification Report form will be signed by the district/BOCES official responsible for verifying the data provided in the Staff Evaluation Rating Verification report and submitted to the Commissioner by November 3, 2017;

 Observation or Principal School Visit Category, and final composite rating, for all teachers and principals
 employed by the district or BOCES, for the 2016-17 school year, and will include both the original and
 transition scores and ratings for all applicable teachers and principals;
- Assure that all data for the Student Performance Category, Teacher Observation or Principal School Visit Category, and final composite rating, for all teachers and principals employed by the district or BOCES, for

the 2016-17 school year is certified by the superintendent and maintained in a central database, and will include both the original and transition scores and ratings for all applicable teachers and principals. The Department reserves the right to require your district or BOCES to provide this data at any time for auditing purposes;
